CAIM 2008 provides a forum for the review of the recent trends in theoretical, numerical and experimental applied and industrial mathematics, in computer sciences and in education activities in mathematics. Its proceedings are published in ROMAI Journal and ROMAI Educational Journal.

Location

CAIM 2008 will take place at Technical College Transilvania, Cazaban Street, No. 48, Oradea, Romania. The best access to the conference location is by taxi, from the train station or from the airport.

Departure from Oradea, a stop in Cluj and the arrival at Vatra Dornei. Supper and accommodation at Hotel Intus **.

October 12

Departure towards the painted monasteries from Bucovina with a stop at the 'Wood Museum' from Campulung Moldovenesc. Arrival at the monastery Moldovita. The visit of the monastery and of its museum where the famous 'Golden apple' will be admired. Departure towards the monastery Sucevita. The visit of the monastery and lunch at 'Poiana fagilor'. Departure towards Marginea where the black ceramics center will be visited. The trip continues to Gura Humorului. The visit of the monasteries Voronet and Humor. Arrival at Suceava. Supper and accommodation at Hotel Albert ** Suceava.

October 13

Breakfast. Departure of the participants.

Participation Fees

Payment must be made with anticipation and it is part of the registration process.

A. 200 RON (or 67 EUR) conference fee. It includes the conference materials, the abstracts, the coffee breaks and the reception. This fee must be paid by all the participants.

The following alternatives are available for housing and meals during the conference (to be paid by the participants):

The hostel (120 persons capacity) and the canteen of the college, that are situated in the building of the college:

D.3. 160 RON or 53 EUR 5 meals (the supper from Oct. 8...the lunch from Oct. 11)

E. Hotel Continental **** (300 persons capacity), Aleea Strandului Street, No. 1 (transport by taxi)

E.1.1. 622,5 RON or 208 EUR 1 bed/room (3 nights accommodation+breakfast/1 person)

E.1.2. 418 RON or 140 EUR 2 beds/room (3 nights accommodation+breakfast/1 person)

F. Excursion at the monasteries from Bucovina

F.1. 400 RON or 133 EUR

For the payment in RON, the money will be transferred into the account RO47BTRL00501201734183XX, Banca Transilvania, Sucursala Oradea, holder Serban E. Vlad. There are two methods of payment:

1. Direct payment at any branch of the Transilvania Bank.

2. Bank transfer ('virament') from any bank.

For the payment in EUR, the money will be transferred into the account RO93BTRL00504201734183XX, Banca Transilvania, Oradea branch, Romania, SWIFT CODE (BIC CODE) BTRLRO22BHA, holder Serban E. Vlad. There is one method of payment, by wire transfer. The correspondent banks of Banca Transilvania (for small commission) are: Deutsche Bank, Commerz Bank, ABN AMRO, Banca Intesa

In both cases, payment in RON or payment in EUR, the commission will be paid by the participant ('COMMISSION OUR').

Fractional payment is accepted, such as $\frac{2}{3} \times E.1.1$ if the participant stays in Oradea only 2 days during the conference.

Before paying, please take a look at our site www.romai.ro to see if the hostel/hotel has free rooms. If it will be the case, we shall delete the accommodation services that are not available.

Simultaneously with the payment, please write us at romai.caim08@gmail.com an explanation of what the paid sum represents, for example: 'I have paid 251 EUR= $A+B.1+B.2+F.1$ '.

Every participant will pay the participation fee at CAIM 2008. ROMAI will make all the possible efforts to offer the participants from the Republic of Moldova scholarships at their arrival at the conference. These scholarships will not exceed the sum represented by $A+B.1+B.2+F.1$.
